

Urine sample collection: Instructions for boys



1. You can collect the sample when it has been at least 4 hours since the child last urinated.
2. You have received a lidded container and a depressurised sample tube for sample collection. Do not remove the tube cap!
3. Wash your hands.
4. Retract the child's foreskin.
5. Wipe the urinary meatus with 3–4 clean and damp toilet tissues.
6. Dry with a toilet tissue.
7. Remove the sample container lid. First, let the child urinate a little into the toilet.
8. Collect an uninterrupted stream of the child's urine (2/3 of the container). Do not touch the inside of the container. The child can let the rest of the urine run into the toilet.
9. Close the sample container lid tightly and remove the lid label. Place the container on a table.
10. Press the sample tube cap first all the way against the sampling needle until urine flows into the tube. Wait until the tube is full.
11. Turn the tube upside down five times.
12. Fill in this document, and deliver it and the sample tube to the laboratory as soon as possible.
